NOTICE OF RACE

- 1 RULES** – The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The Organizing Authority is the Lake Norman Yacht Club in conjunction with the Soverel 33 Class Association.
- 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY** – The regatta is open to Soverel 33 boats eligible in accordance with S33 ODCR IV and that have completed registration and paid all fees by Thursday 10, July 2008.
- 3 FEES** – The entry fee is \$100 postmarked by 26 June 2008 and \$115 for later entries.

5 NUMBER OF RACES – The Race Committee plans to run 3 races Friday, 2 races Saturday and 2 races Sunday. No race will start after 1300 Sun. One race will constitute a regatta.

6 MEASUREMENTS – Each boat shall comply with Soverel 33 ODCR section III.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – The Sailing Instructions and Notice of Race will be available at registration.

8 VENUE & COURSES – Rendezvous for the start will be in the vicinity of Channel Marker D7. The courses will be windward – leeward with a weather offset and leeward gate if deemed necessary by the RC. See Sailing Instructions.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM – Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed such that a boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 while racing may take a penalty by making One Turn including one tack and one gybe that, in all other respects, complies with RRS 44.2, However, if a boat breaks a rule of Part 2 within the two-length zone of any rounding or finishing mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty in compliance with RRS 44.2.

10 SCORING – The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A2, will apply. All races will be scored except, if six or more races are completed, a boat's worst score will be excluded.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION – The race committee intends to use channel 71 to broadcast information to competitors, including OCS hails after the start.

12 PRIZES – Prizes will be awarded for first through third place. The Bill Soverel Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner.

DIRECTIONS

On Southbound **I-77** take **Exit 36** and turn onto **Hwy 150 West**. Go approx. ½ mile, at top of rise and turn left onto **Williamson Rd.** Go approx. ½ mile to second light and turn right onto **Brawley School Rd.** After approx. 6 miles turn left onto **Yacht Rd.** **LNyc** is approx. ½ mile on the left.

On Northbound **I-77** take **Exit 33** and turn left onto **Williamson Rd.** Go approx. 3 miles to third light and turn left onto **Brawley School Rd.** After approx. 6 miles turn left onto **Yacht Rd.** **LNyc** is approx. ½ mile on the left.

LODGING
